

## Quiz Bowl

Quiz Bowl is a student activity sponsored by professional associations in agricultural economics: the Southern Agricultural Economics Association (SAEA) and the Agricultural and Applied Economics Association (AAEA). Any undergraduate student in the Department is eligible to participate. Two teams of three students compete against each other by answering questions from a Jeopardy!-style board. Each round is 15 minutes and consists of questions in agricultural economics, primarily based on material from undergraduate courses, plus a few general knowledge questions.



Two competitions are held each year. The first is in late January/early February at the SAEA meeting and the second takes place in late July/early August at the AAEA meeting. The Department typically provides full support for 3-6 students to attend both meetings.



In short, Quiz Bowl is opportunity for students to:

- Build résumés
- Travel to professional meetings for FREE
- Network with potential employers and/or graduate schools
- Meet and compete against other students from across the U.S. and Canada
